#### A-Z Maps Online

- Use the menu on the left to select a "Country Map"
- Choose "Modern Country Maps" and search for the country that you are researching

#### A-Z The World

- Begin at the Resource Guide for "Mr. Pilarowski's Geography Class"
- Select "A-Z The World" and login using Grandview's username and password
- Use the list of the left to select a "Country Guide" and begin your research!

#### **ABC-CLIO World Geography**

- Begin at the Resource Guide for "Mr. Pilarowski's Geography Class"
- Select "ABC-CLIO World Geography." This will bring you to ALL ABC-CLIO Databases
- Select "World Geography" from the list on the right
- Use the "Explore Regions" section to navigate to your country and begin your research!

С	Currency: The timeliness of the information  ☐ When was the information published or posted? ☐ Is the information current enough for your topic, of is it out-of-date? ☐ Do the links work? ☐ When was the information last reviewed/revised/updated?
R	Relevance: The importance of the information for your research needs  Is the information at an appropriate level?  How comprehensive or in-depth is the discussion of the topic?
A	<ul> <li>Authority: The source of the information</li> <li>☐ Have the author's credentials or organizational affiliations been identified?</li> <li>☐ Who is the owner/sponsor of the Website? A	<ul> <li>Accuracy: The reliability, truthfulness, and correctness of the information/content</li> <li>□ Have the author's sources been clearly cited so that you can easily find/check them?</li> <li>□ Is the information available in other resources/can you double check it?</li> <li>□ Does the language/tone seem unbiased and free from emotion?</li> <li>□ Are there spelling, grammar, or other obvious errors?</li> </ul>
Р	<ul> <li>Purpose: The reason the information exists</li> <li>□ What is the purpose of the information (to inform, teach, sell, entertain, persuade)?</li> <li>□ Do the authors/sponsors make their intentions clear?</li> <li>□ Is advertising content clearly labeled?</li> <li>□ Does the point of view appear objective, unbiased and impartial?</li> </ul>
