Amazon® Kindle

What you need

- An OverDrive-powered library website
- A Kindle or a Kindle reading app
- OverDrive app, <http://app.overdrive.com/>
- The USB cable for your Kindle
- An Amazon account
- Your active directory username and your staff or student ID number

Step 1: Install software

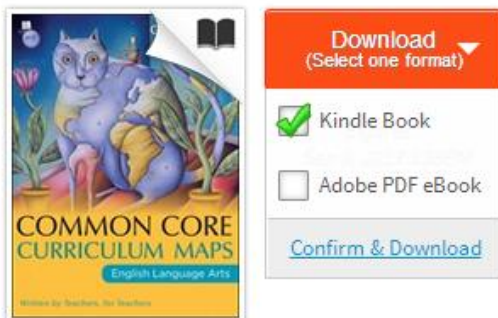
For Kindle 1st gen, 2nd gen, DX, Keyboard, Paperwhite, Touch: No software is needed to checkout eBooks. Use a computer to checkout Kindle format books; sign into your Amazon Kindle account; download to Kindle by USB or Wi-Fi.

For Kindle Fire: Download the OverDrive app from your device's app store (see page 24). You will need to authorize your Kindle with an OverDrive account to read compatible formats: EPUB and PDF eBooks, and MP3 audiobooks.

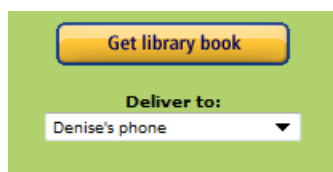
Step 2: Browse, check out, download

For Kindle 1st gen, 2nd gen, DX, Keyboard, Paperwhite, Touch: From a computer, view the [OverDrive](#) Digital Library, <http://cherrycreekschools.lib.overdrive.com>, and check out any book. If you only want to see Kindle format books, it may be helpful to use the advanced search feature. Confirm & Download the checkout.

Library eBooks that come in a Kindle format can be read on Kindles and Kindle reading apps on many devices. Kindles with a Wi-Fi internet connection can download most books directly from

Amazon. Some Kindles may require you to manually transfer the eBooks from your PC or Mac via USB. You can check out Amazon's support page for instructions on how to do this.

If your device supports Wi-Fi delivery, start your Kindle or Kindle app to complete the download.

Certain publishers' titles are not available for over-the-air delivery. If over-the-air delivery is not available, you will need to download the title to a computer, and then load it on to your Kindle via USB.

Check out and download an MP3 audiobook using your PC or Mac computer. Open the file in the OverDrive app. Connect the iPod to your computer, start the “Transfer” wizard and follow instructions.

Chromebook

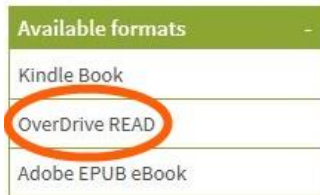

Select the “Chrome web store” on your chromebook and search for “Overdrive” and download the app.

Step 2: Browse, check out, download

For eBooks or audiobooks

1. Open the OverDrive app on your device. Find your library, Cherry Creek Schools District Library and log in. Or use your browser to open the Overdrive Digital Library, <http://cherrycreekschools.lib.overdrive.com> and log in.
2. When you find an eBook you'd like to borrow, make sure it's available in OverDrive Read or epub by checking the “Available formats” listed on its details page. Audiobooks in either MP3 or LISTEN format may be used.



3. Click Borrow to check out the eBook or audiobook.

Go to your bookshelf to display the title(s) you have checked out. From here, you can click **Read** to start reading eBooks in your browser, or download the epub version to the app. For audiobooks, choose **LISTEN** to open in the browser or choose **MP3** to download to the app.

Once you deliver a library book to your Kindle or Kindle reading app, it reads just like any other Kindle Book. Any notes you take, or bookmarks you make will be saved. If you ever check out the same title again, or buy it from the Kindle store, you'll find your notes safe and sound right where you left them.

Another option is to read eBooks borrowed from your library on Kindle Cloud Reader. All you need is a compatible browser (Chrome or Safari) and an Internet connection. As long as you're online, you can read Kindle Books right from your web browser.

When you read Kindle Books from your library, your bookmarks, notes, and reading progress are all synced with your Kindle account. That means, if you make a note in a book you're reading on the Kindle Cloud Reader, you can look at it later on your Kindle or Kindle Reading App as long as you have Internet access.

OverDrive Account

An OverDrive account is free and is required to read digitally protected (DRM) eBooks in **newer** versions of the OverDrive app. With an OverDrive account, you have the ability to download the same eBooks and audiobooks on multiple devices, sync your reading or listening progress between devices, and more.

You can also use an OverDrive account to authorize Adobe Digital Editions on your computer. If you do that, you'll be able to download the same eBooks on your computer and in the OverDrive app.

First-time eBook users will be prompted to activate their computer or device:

- Authorize the computer or device with an OverDrive account.
- If you do not have an OverDrive account:
 1. Create one when prompted when you download the OverDrive app or on OverDrive.com, <https://www.overdrive.com/account/sign-up>
 2. When you create an OverDrive account, you'll be asked to verify your email address. To complete the process, click the link in the verification email sent by OverDrive.
 3. After you sign up for an OverDrive account, OverDrive will automatically activate new devices for you when you sign in on each one. You can have up to six devices synced and authorized with your account.

Adobe Activation

An Adobe ID is a free user account that lets you download digitally protected (DRM) eBooks in **older** versions of the OverDrive app or on a computer. To download the same eBooks on multiple computers or devices, each computer or device needs to be authorized with the same Adobe ID.

You only need an Adobe ID if your device doesn't work with an OverDrive account and if you want to download DRM-protected eBooks. You do not need an Adobe ID to read eBooks in your browser, or for audiobooks, music, or videos.

First-time eBook users will be prompted to activate their computer or device:

- Authorize the computer or device with an Adobe ID.
- If you do not have an Adobe ID:
 - a. Create one on <http://adobe.com>
 - b. Return to the software and authorize the computer or device with the new ID. To enjoy eBooks on additional computers and devices, be sure to authorize each with the same Adobe ID. You may authorize up to 6 computers and/or devices.
 - c. Once authorized, you are able to check authorization information via the Help menu in Adobe Digital Editions.

How to install Adobe Digital Editions on a PC or Mac computer

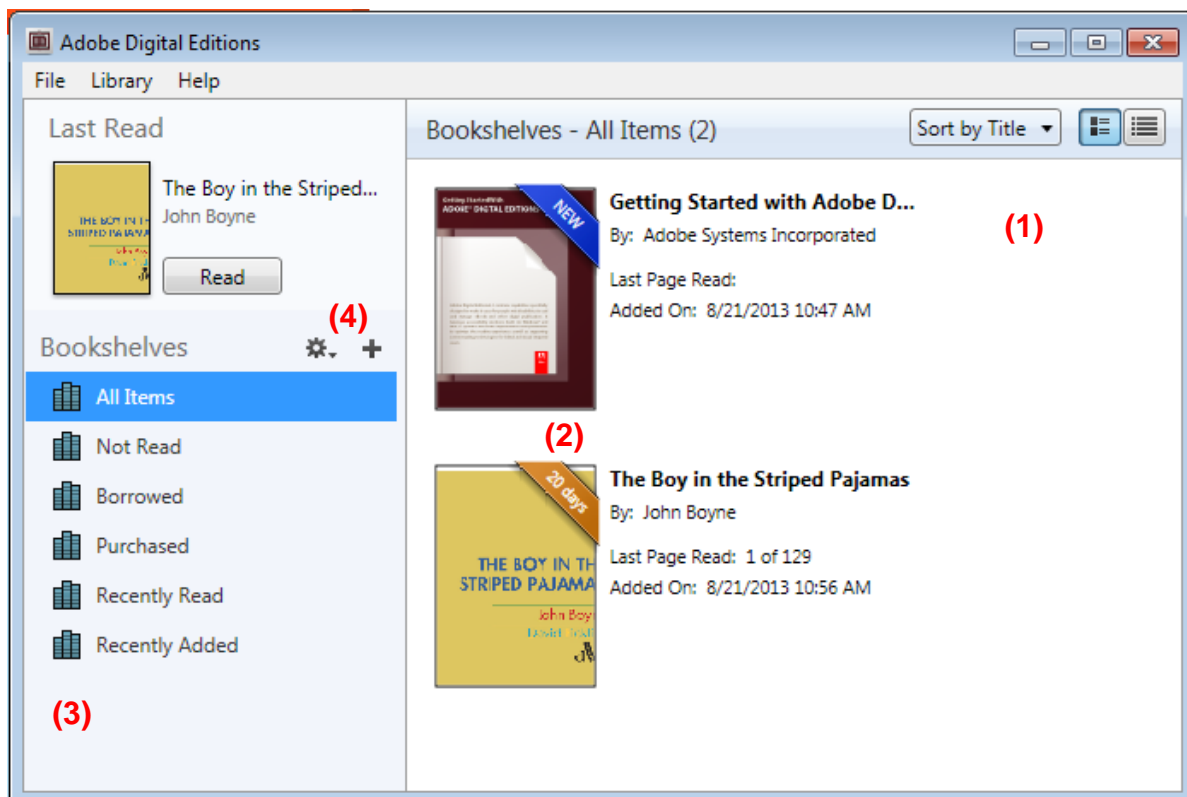
Step 1: Go to the Adobe Digital Editions website, <http://www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html>, and click 'Download Now' on the right side of the screen.

Step 2: Download the version of Adobe Digital Editions for your computer. The download process will begin automatically. You will need to review and accept the Digital Editions license agreement before continuing.

Step 3: Once you click next, you will be prompted to select or de-select the components you wish to install on your computer. To accept defaults, click next to complete installation. Adobe Digital Editions will open automatically once the download and installation has been completed.

Getting to Know Adobe Digital Editions

- Checked out items will display in the center of the window (1). A sample eBook has been pre-loaded into your Adobe Digital Editions. Refer to these eBook helpful tips for using the software. Note the blue banner across the cover art that says 'New'. As days pass, the library book displays the time remaining on the loan (2). Other helpful information displayed is when the title was added to your library, and what page you left off on.
- When your device is connected to your computer, you will see it displayed under the 'Bookshelves' section on the left toolbar (3). You have the ability to add or delete other bookshelves using the gear icon or plus sign (4).
- If you prefer to read the title on your computer, double click the cover art to read it full screen.



How to install the OverDrive app on a PC or Mac computer

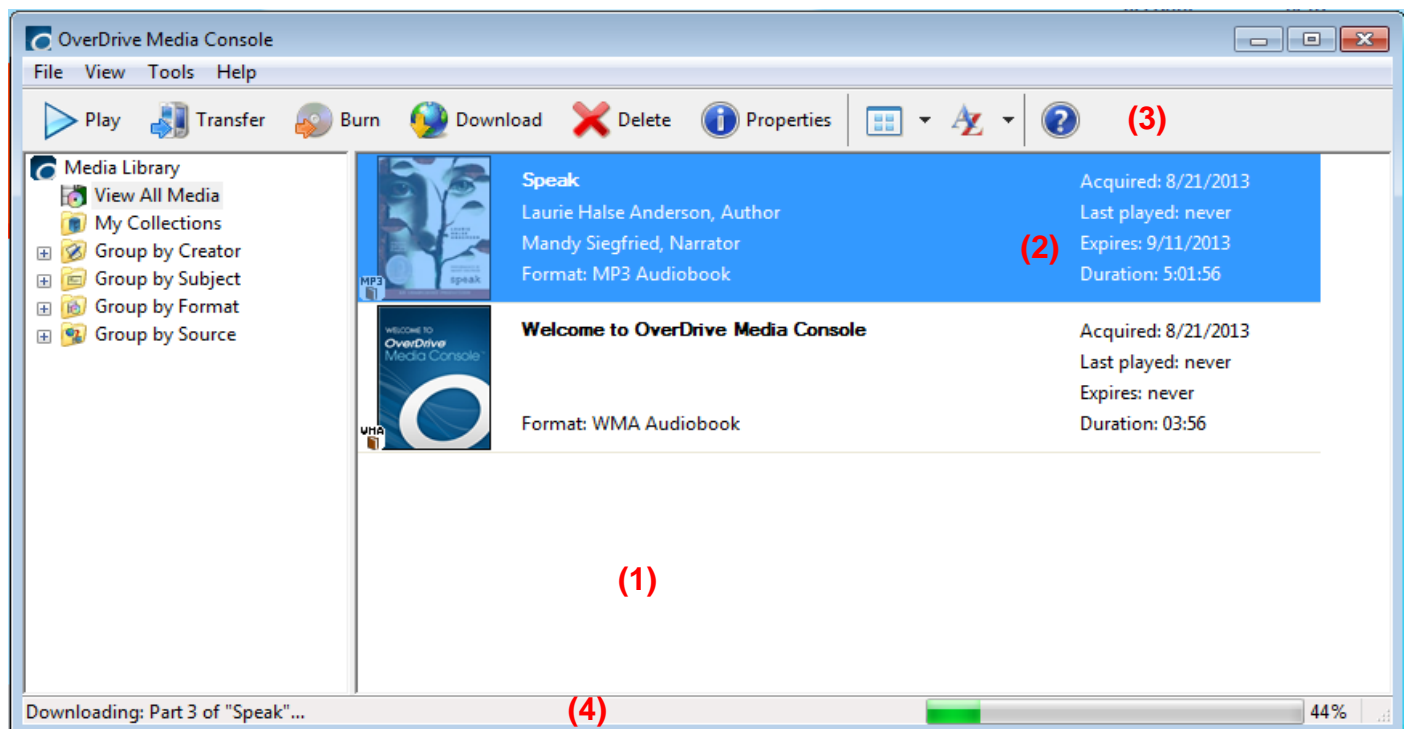
Step 1: Go to the OverDrive website, <http://app.overdrive.com/>, and click 'Get Started'.

Step 2: Download the version of OverDrive for your computer. The download process will begin automatically. Click 'Run' or 'Next' to progress through to installation wizard. You will need to review and accept the OverDrive license agreement before continuing.

Step 3: To accept system defaults, click next to complete installation. OverDrive for Windows or Mac will open automatically once the download and installation has been completed.

Getting to Know OverDrive for Windows or Mac

- Checked out items will display in the center of the window (1). A sample audiobook has been pre-loaded into OverDrive. Refer to this audiobook for helpful tips about using the software. Helpful information is displayed, like the expiration date for your library loans (2), when the title was added to your library and how long the audiobook is.
- A selected title will be highlighted in blue. When a title is selected, you will be able to interact with the upper toolbar (3). This toolbar allows you to play the title on your computer, transfer it to a device, burn it to a CD, download additional parts, or delete it from your library.
- When you download an audiobook, you will be prompted to select the download folder for the title. Click 'Ok' to accept the default, or click 'Browse' to change the file location. Audiobooks download in parts. By default all parts are selected. You can select or de-select parts of the audiobook as desired. The status of your download is in the lower right of the OverDrive window (4).



How to install the OverDrive app on an Android device

Install the OverDrive app from the device's App Store or the Android Apps section of Google Play

1. Search for 'OverDrive' on your device's app store, or on Google Play, <https://play.google.com/store>
2. From your computer or device, click or tap the **Install** button. The app permissions are displayed.
3. Click or tap the **OK** button to download and install OverDrive for Android.
4. Tap **Open** to launch OverDrive for Android.

How to Download Adobe Flash Player for Computer (Digital Video Streaming)

Most videos available through OverDrive are able to be viewed right in your browser, which will open as soon as you hit “play” on the video from your bookshelf. However, some may be DRM-protected and will need to be played through the OverDrive app on iOS or Android devices, or through Adobe Flash Player for your desktop or laptop computer. Most browsers have Adobe Flash Player installed already, but if yours doesn’t, follow the instructions below for a free download.

What you need

- Your computer (Linux, Mac, or Windows)
- Adobe Flash Player, <http://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/otherversions/>

Download Adobe Flash Player

1. Use the URL above to reach the download page
2. Click the drop-down box labeled “Select an Operating System”



3. Select your system, and then the latest version for the browser available to you based on your system.

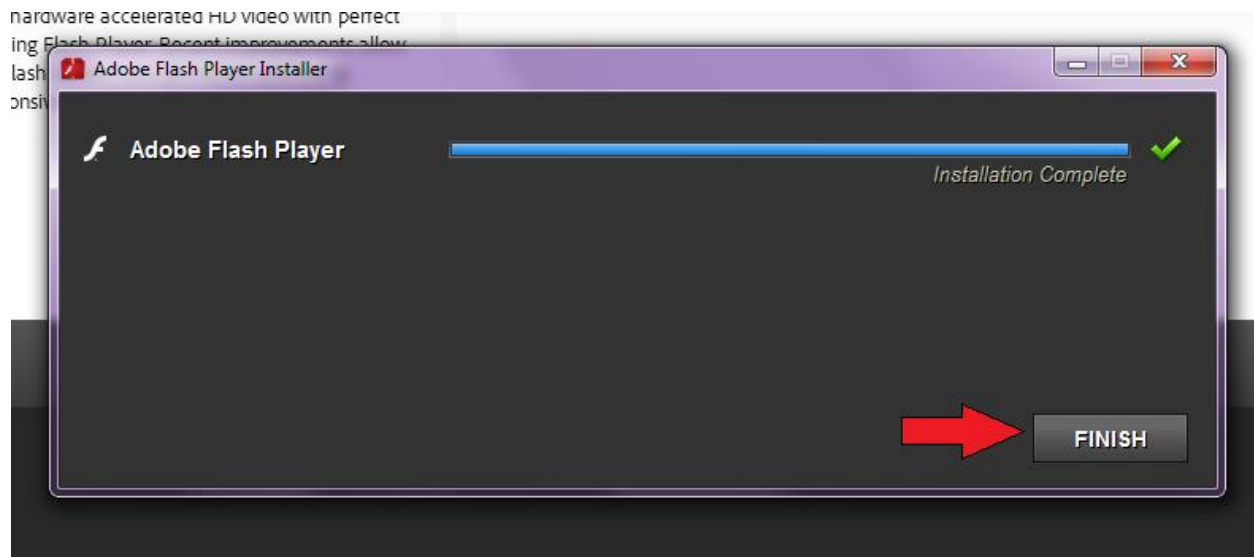


4. Click "Download Now"
